Key Responsibilities and Accountabilities:

Provides outpatient therapy, psychotherapy and counseling for individuals, families, children or groups. Implementation of treatment activity designed to reduce maladaptive behaviors, maximize behavioral self-control, or restore normalized psychological functioning, reality orientation, remotivation, and emotional adjustment, thus enabling improved functioning and more appropriate interpersonal and social relationships. Utilizes evidence based treatments within their scope of practice. Acts as a liaison within the community to ensure continuum of care and support for customers. Acts as a clinical resource for agency teams and may conduct educational presentations. Treatment is provided within clinic settings - crisis activities may occur within community settings. Therapeutic supports are provided as outlined in the individualized plan of service based on person-centered planning and utilizing evidence based practices. Completes intervention documentation according to agency guidelines. Maintains record compliance within agency requirements and standards utilizing electronic/hard copy record formats. Shall ensure compliance and participation with competency improvement activities. Must obtain and maintain professional liability insurance with a minimum of \$1,000,000/\$3,000,000 aggregate.

Qualifications and Capabilities:

- Master's Degree in social work with certification by the State of Michigan as a licensed Master's level social worker (LMSW).
- Two years of experience in a behavioral health care setting utilizing evidenced based practices and behavior modification techniques. Must meet criteria for Child Mental Health professional if providing mental health services to minors.
- One year of electronic medical record experience preferred.

To Apply:
